

FIT Community Service Scholarship Grant Established 2009

Keeping the Focus Where It Matters

This scholarship is an annual grant in the amount of \$500.00 to be awarded to the Toronto High School student who best exemplifies the ideals of community, charity, and action. The scholarship will be awarded based on a blind application system, and will be centered on a points system. The scholarship is both merit and need based. Family of members of the Focus on Toronto Committee will not be eligible. At this time, the scholarship is based on an expendable fund basis; however, in the future it may be changed to an endowment.

Enrollment Criteria

Any student graduating from Toronto High School in the calendar year of the award and is accepted at an institute of higher learning and/or is enlisted for US military service is eligible for consideration.

GPA

There is no GPA requirement for consideration for this award; however, points will be awarded for GPA based on a weighted scale.

Education Objective Criteria

Future academic plans will also be considered in the award criteria; however no student will be refused consideration for the grant, regardless of his/her future academic intentions.

Fund Utilization Criteria

Student will be awarded a check for the full amount of the award, and may utilize the award as he/she sees fit.

Essay Grading

Applicants must include an original essay of between 750 to 1000 words in length. The essay topic will be "What Public Service Means to Me." Themes your essay should cover include how public service has impacted your life, how you intend to include public service in your future, and why you would suggest public service to others. The essay should be double spaced with headers and subheads where appropriate. Points will be deducted for grammar and spelling errors.

Ineligibility Stipulation

Relatives of current voting or non-voting members of the Focus in Toronto (FIT) Organization are not eligible to receive this grant. For the purposes of this grant, "relatives" shall be defined as offspring, siblings, nieces, nephews, aunts, uncles or first-cousins and shall not apply whether the relationship is through blood or by marriage.
